

RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

PLEASE READ, SIGN & DATE (Page 2) AND RETURN (VENDORS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED WITHOUT SIGNED FORM ON FILE)

The risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and guests with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable.

When selling at the Sacramento Antique Faire, you voluntarily waive all claims and assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19 while participating in the Faire, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Sacramento Antique Faire, the City of Sacramento, and the State of California, their respective boards, officers, employees, and sub-contractors against any and all claims and causes of action related to COVID-19 exposure.

You also agree in consideration of the opportunity to enter and sell goods at the Faire to follow the COVID-19 Mitigation Plan set forth below. Compliance with these rules is mandatory for all vendors in attendance so as to meet the safety guidelines suggested by the State of California and the County of Sacramento Departments of Public Health as well as those of the Center for Disease Control and Prevention. Initial Here	VENDOR REQUIREMENTS	
	• Please do not attend the Faire if you have respiratory or flu-like symptoms or if you are sick	
	• Must maintain social distance of 6 feet from other vendors, customers, and helpers that do not live	
	in the same household	
	• Face coverings/masks must be worn at all times (if using face shield, you must still wear a mask)	
	• Clean & disinfect your goods and surfaces.	
	• Provide hand sanitizer for customer use	
	• Draw two (2) markings on the ground 6 feet apart in front of your booth to indicate proper social	
	distancing to customers (chalk will be supplied at check-in)	
	• Gloves (single-purpose use only) for receiving cash/giving change & showing merchandise. Keep a	
	trash bag in your space to dispose of used gloves	
	• Payment for space rent for the September & October Faires should be made by check or money order	
	and mailed in the enclosed envelope OR call our office at (916) 600-9770 to pay by credit card/to	
	make other arrangements.	
	We will reassess payment procedures going forward - after the October Faire	
	• STRONGLY RECOMMENDED: Soap and water in a spray bottle (for your hands), paper towels, and	
	eyewear (sunglasses, safety goggles, or a face shield)
